(3) Third China-Korea-Japan Joint Conference on Meteorology

13-16 November 2007, Beijing, China

(4) Fourth Japan-China-Korea Joint Conference on Meteorology

8-11 November 2009, Tsukuba, Japan

After the consultation on the successful cooperation, the three Societies have reached the

agreement to continue the second round of the Joint Conferences once in every two years. As the

fourth conference was held in 2009, the next one is going to be held in 2011 in Korea. Here we
